System Description

1. The AEC Electronic Checklist is a stand alone system with no interfacing of other aircraft equipment. It provides operating procedural information for the type aircraft for which it is installed.
2. During normal operations, view any set of "Checks" from any of the Emergency or Abnormal columns of information, then return to that same place at the same place at the press of the required page button, or automatically return to that completion of that page of checks.
3. Internal backlighting allows text to be read day or night. Up to three "check lines" are visible at any one time. The active lines are Highlighted on the screen display for easy identification.
4. By depressing the Emergency button, Emergency information will be displayed immediately and, depending on how the Checklist has been programmed, will access those checks relating to that phase of operation. Each time any of the four Page buttons is pressed it will access the next Page. The Back- Page button will recall the previous pages one at a time in the same manner. If the checklist unit is fitted with Speech capability, it will announce the Page Headings as they are opened in the forward mode only.
